Quality, Handling & Cold-Chain

For international bulk seafood, product integrity depends on disciplined handling from harvest and processing through frozen storage and delivery. Meridean Seafoods can present shipment specifications and supporting documentation appropriate to the destination market and buyer agreement.

Frozen integrity	Product should remain continuously frozen throughout storage and transportation.
Traceability	Lot, harvest, processing and packing information should be maintained for each shipment.
Packaging integrity	Export cartons should be clean, intact, properly labeled and suitable for frozen seafood.
Specification control	Size/count, glazing, net weight, processing style and pack configuration should match the agreed purchase order.
Documentation	Commercial and export documentation should match the actual shipment and destination requirements.
Destination compliance	Health certificates, establishment eligibility, labeling and import permits may vary by destination.

Packaging, Logistics & Bulk Supply

The commercial specification can be tailored to the buyer's market. Before quoting, confirm the exact species, grade, processing form, carton weight, order quantity, destination, required documents and Incoterm.

Commercial Item	Recommended Listing Detail
Minimum order quantity	Negotiable — specify the minimum tonnage/carton quantity you can reliably supply
Supply capacity	Insert verified monthly or seasonal capacity
Packaging	Bulk export cartons; state net weight per carton and pallet configuration
Loading	Containerized frozen cargo; final loading plan depends on product and logistics provider
Trade terms	FOB / CFR / CIF / other agreed Incoterm
Payment	T/T, L/C or other agreed terms subject to contract and buyer verification
Lead time	Quote after confirming stock, production schedule and destination requirements
Shipping documents	Commercial invoice, packing list, certificate of origin and other applicable certificates/permits

How to Request a Wholesale Quote

1. State the destination country and port.
2. Specify required shrimp species, size/count and processing style.
3. State required quantity and preferred carton size.
4. Confirm required certificates, labeling and inspection documentation.
5. Request price on the preferred Incoterm (FOB, CFR, CIF, etc.).
6. Agree product specification, payment terms, delivery schedule and inspection requirements in writing.
